FIRE to IRIS

FIRE System Retiring

The IRS FIRE system is scheduled to be retired at the end of 2026. Filers must use the Information Returns Intake System (IRIS) for 2026 tax returns in the 2027 filing season.

Tips for Transitioning

- Make sure your county has applied for the IRIS TCC – it takes up to 45 days to receive after applying
