MnCCC provides an opportunity, through our joint powers agreements with counties (and cities, agencies, and Tribal Nations), to collaborate on software solutions. We have software User Groups that work together to provide Minnesota-specific software for use in county departments. Some groups own and manage their software; other groups are using off-the-shelf software that has been customized for Minnesota.

Our Mission



Established in 1978, Minnesota Counties Computer Cooperative (MnCCC) works with all Minnesota Counties as a joint powers organization facilitating services and training, providing software and other cost-effective measures to substantially reduce technology costs for counties, cities, agencies, and Tribal Nations.

Joint Powers



MnCCC is formed under Minnesota Statute §471.59 as a joint powers. MnCCC members – counties, cities, state agencies, Tribal Nations, and other joint powers – can join together to create a legal entity for the purpose of contracting.



What We Do

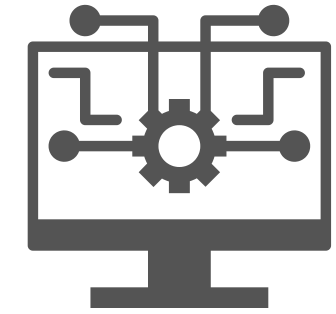

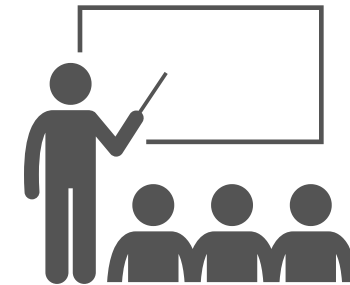

Our User Groups

What are User Groups?

Our User Groups are made of counties, cities, agencies, and Tribal Nations contracting under MnCCC. This User Group model allows for groups to share in funding projects, contracting under MnCCC, and other services necessary to make their product(s) work for them.

Each User Group is associated with one or more contract(s) that provide an essential service by department or agency. MnCCC also has 4 software User Groups that own and manage their own software. Other groups are using off-the-shelf software that has been customized for Minnesota.



MnCCC Board

The MnCCC Board is made up of 4 Executive Officers, 4 Regional Representatives, 1 At-Large Representative, and 1 Technical Representative. The Board oversees the creation and management of User Groups and committees, engages with Membership, represents MnCCC, and negotiates and executes contracts that support organizational needs and goals. The MnCCC Board meets monthly, usually on the second Thursday of the month in a hybrid format.

Why a Board?



Because MnCCC is formed under Minnesota statute, a governing Board has been established to oversee MnCCC's high-level operations and any obligations MnCCC may have, including contracts, policies, Bylaws, and Joint Powers Agreements.

Who Can Join?



Any full- or part-time employee of an MnCCC member county, city, agency, or Tribal Nation is eligible to assume a position on the MnCCC Board. Each position's office shall be open for nomination and election at MnCCC's Annual Business Meeting during the MnCCC Conference.

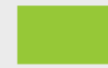
How to Get Involved

Northeast



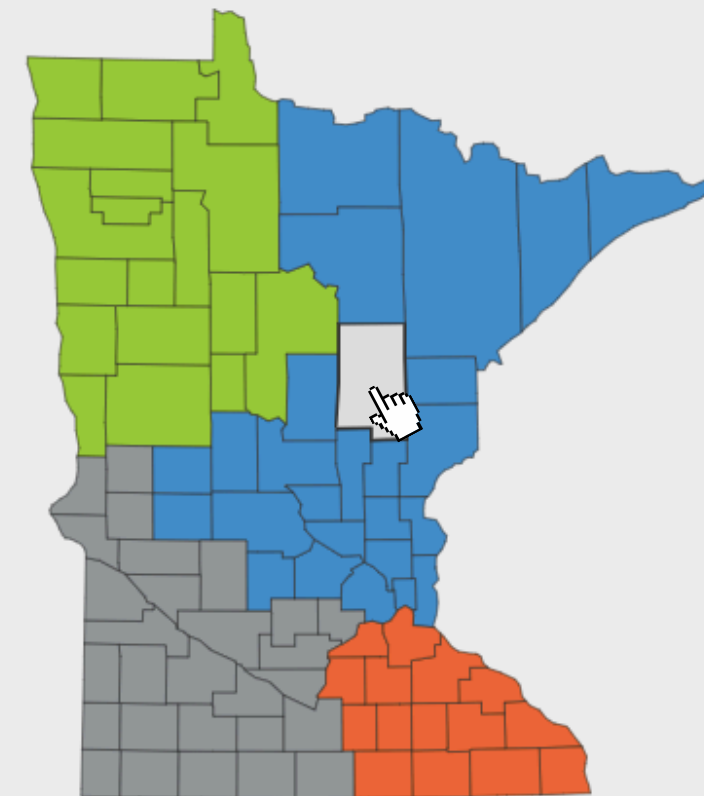
Region 3:

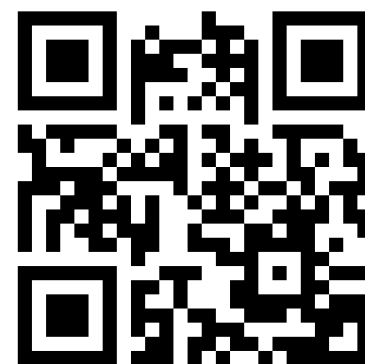
